Hazelnut Research

Analysis of hybrid hazelnuts is wrapping up.

The NRE project has allowed for expanded contacts. Results of this work have led to an expansion of hybrid hazelnut trials with collaboration with Rutgers University and private breeders. In addition, UNL has been recipient of seed from a private breeder in Illinois and from cultivar collection in Russia via collaboration with Rutgers. Thus, the UNL site will increase its hazelnut trials from two acres to almost four acres.

Due to the momentum in the hazelnut work funded by the NRE project, a SARE grant has been awarded to focus on woody florals and hazelnuts with partners from the NRE project, Fort Berthold and NICC.
